Denny Arcas, 3rd generation family member to run Arcas Machine, contacted BMSC 3 years ago to prepare Arcas Machine for ISO 9001/AS9100 certification. With BMSC's support, Arcas Machine certified to ISO 9001/AS9100 first in 2013 with 'no findings' in their audit and successfully each year after. Bretta Kelly and colleague Debbie Hart continue to work with Denny and his team on a regular basis, as Arcas Machine contracted with BMSC for the 'ISO/AS9100 Maintenance Package', which entails quarterly internal audits and management reviews.

Denny and Chris Kornegay first met when their businesses were located in the same
